

Downloading and Self-Printing Tips

- 1) To download images, find the gallery you like and then click the "SELECT PHOTOS" button in the upper right-hand corner. Images can be selected individually or can be selected by clicking the "ALL" in the upper left corner. After selection is made, then click the "DOWNLOAD" button in the upper right corner. A window will open, asking for an email address. Type in your email address and click the "DOWNLOAD" button. Check your email for a message from FLASHBACK PHOTOGRAPHY. In the email, you will find a link ending in ".zip". Click the link. Now select where you want your pictures to be downloaded. Most people have their images go to their DESKTOP. Once you have selected a location, click the "SAVE" to download the file containing the images. This file is called a "zip file" and looks like a folder with a zipper. Find this file and double-click on it to open it. You should see all the JPEG images you selected from the website. These JPEG files can be copied into another file or directly onto another form of media (CD, thumb drive, etc). Be sure not to copy the zip file itself onto another media as you will have trouble printing. I suggest copying images from the zip file into another file on the DESKTOP and then working with that new file.
- 2) Copy the file onto media. I suggest at least a 4GB thumb drive or DVD. If you have several hundred pictures, you may need to get as 8GB thumb drive. Since the images are quite large, I do not recommend using a CD.
- 3) With the images copied to media, take the pictures to get printed. We like Sam's Club, but you can go anywhere.
- 4) **IMPORTANT:** When printing images, be sure to disable "Auto-Enhance". Our pictures have already been color-enhanced. Forgetting to do so will result in over-saturated pictures.
